### Long Melford 1 - 1 Whitton United Thurlow Nunn Premier, 18 September

Melford started on the offensive with George Day bringing Whitton keeper Jack Spurling into early action, and in another Melford attack Hassan Ally fired into the side netting.

On 25 minutes Whitton looked to have taken the lead but the header from Josh Hubert hit the Melford goal post and went out of play.

On 32 minutes Melford took the lead Day crossed into the box, as a result a Will Wingfield effort was blocked. eventually the ball came loose to the man from Tenerife DAVID LOPEZ and his fine left foot went in off the post.

Minutes into the second half with the Melford defence showing a lack of concentration, Whitton levelled when a cross from the Whitton left wing was neatly headed home by OLLY DUNLOP who had just come from the subs bench.

On 68 minutes keeper Spurling kept Whitton in the game with a fine save from a Jacob Brown volley.

On 80 minutes Melford should have taken a lead when from what looked like an offside position Hassan Ally through on goal held on to the ball too long and keeper Spurling dived to save at his feet.

Ironically three minutes earlier Jamie Griffiths had fired into the net from what looked an onside position, but to his surprise the goal was ruled offside.



The Villagers went into the lead after 2 minutes a long David Lopez throw, caused mayhem in the Burnham defence and JAKE JACKSON converted from close range. On six minutes Melford increased their lead from a George Day corner BEN JUDGE headed firmly into the net.

After nineteen minutes Melford increased their lead a pin point pass from George Day released the unmarked BEN JUDGE who cut in from the Melford left flank to fire home. Somehow Melford started to over relax their grip on the game and Burnham got a goal back on 39 minutes when a left wing cross was headed home by LIAM BARRY.

Melford introduced Jamie Griffiths for the injured James Dormady at half-time, and within 40 seconds of the kick off a Judge cross saw JAMIE GRIFFITHS stoop to head home. Soon after this Griffiths tricked his way into the Burnham box and his placed shot hit the bar and went out of play.

On 64 minutes a corner was not cleared by the Melford defence and BEN WOOD rifled the ball home. This energised the home team and Matt Walker in the Melford goal brought off three excellent saves the preserve the Melford lead. On 69 minutes the Ramblers got another goal back when SHEMANE PERKINS-PALMER ran through to find the net.

# **TODAY'S OPPOSITION**



Mulbarton Wanderers FC was established in 1993 when the youth team of Mulbarton United – a now-defunct Anglian Combination side – broke away to form their own youth team.

They merged with the Harford Belles girls team in 2001 and established a mens senior league team starting in division four of the Central and South Norfolk League.

The club won promotion in their first year and continued to rise through the league, getting to division one for the start of the 2007–08 season. They were promoted to the Anglian Combination Division Six in 2009, and achieved six successive promotions, reaching the Premier Division in 2015.

After finishing second in 2018, the club successfully applied to join the Eastern Counties League, entering in Division One North for 2018–19.

Their first season in the Eastern Counties football league saw the club enter the FA Vase for the first time, and the following season saw the club enter the FA Cup for the first time losing out to Boston Town in the extra preliminary round.

In 2021 the club were promoted to the Premier Division based on their results in the abandoned 2019–20 and 2020–21 seasons.

### **MELFORD MEMORIES**



Long Melford Football Club is extremely proud of our association with William Nevill Cobbold, the only player in the club's 150+ year history to play for England.

Born in Long Melford in 1863, William (perhaps better known as "Nuts" Cobbold) played in most of the club's earliest matches as centre-forward. The nickname "Nuts" is said to originate from William's school days because he was "extremely hard to crack".

As well as playing for his village team, William represented Cambridge University and also played for Corinthians.

William was capped nine times for his country between 1883 and 1887, scoring six goals. He made his debut in a 7-0 win against Ireland in February 1883, scoring twice in three minutes.

Widely regarded as one of the best footballers of the Victorian era, William was described in his Times obituary as "the most individually brilliant dribbler, the player who could most often put in those thrusts that no skill could parry".

As well as being a gifted footballer, William represented Cambridge University at tennis and was a handy cricketer, making one appearance for Kent.

In later life William was a successful tutor, working as a "crammer" who prepared boys for entry into the British Army.


